SPEEDY MAGAZINE RELEASE

new Beretta push button magazine release facilitates high speed insertion and extraction of the magazine.

SPEEDY RELOADING SYSTEM


after the last shot, the slide automatically remains open, due to the slide catch being actuated by the follower, so that the empty magazine may be ejected simultaneously by pressing the magazine release and a new magazine immediately inserted.

SUPERIOR POINTABILITY

the slanted pistol grip provides easier aiming. Newly designed stocks are both easier and faster to grip. Cartridges now enter the chamber with reduced loading angle.


EXCLUSIVE SIMPLIFIED TAKEDOWN

FIELD STRIP

- 1 First remove magazine, then draw the slide back for a look into the chamber and check that it is empty. (Cock hammer first to facilitate backward movement of slide).

To remove magazine, keep push button magazine release pressed down until the magazine is fully out. Reassemble in reverse order.

- 2 Hold pistol in left hand. Push slide back with right hand till notch on the lower edge of the right side of the slide is opposite the slide lock. With left thumb rotate matted button of slide lock counterclockwise as shown by arrow.



- 3** The slide is thus released and permitted to come forward, on the front.



- 4** To remove barrel, release recoil spring guide with its spring, pushing it slightly forward to disengage from notch in the slide. (Be careful since the recoil spring is tightened). Proceed as shown in figure 4.





Cleaning

TAKE CARE OF YOUR GUN, IT WILL LAST LONGER AND YOU WILL GET THE BEST RESULTS. KEEP IT CLEAN AND LUBRICATED THROUGHOUT. AFTER EACH FIRING, CLEAN BARREL TO AVOID OXIDATION.

The trigger pull is adjustable by means of a conic screw acting on the sear; it can be reduced up to 22 ounces. (Remove right plastic grip; the screw is near the disconnector). Enlarged grips. 10 round magazine.


